

Take a Test Drive


Want to take Liberty for a spin? Don't want to bother installing software?

This is your ticket! To test drive Liberty, just follow the steps for one of the following methods:

Microsoft Windows Users - Method 1



1. Click [here](#) to download a launcher to connect to the demo Liberty Cloud server.
2. If prompted by your web browser, click **Save**.
3. Double-click on the downloaded file, **libertydemo.rdp**
4. If you get a dialog option asking you to verify the connection, checkmark the option for **Don't ask me again for connections to this computer** and then click the **Connect** button.




5. You may see an option to **Use a different account**, click this, if you don't see this option, go ahead and continue typing **demo** for the user name and then **demo** for the password.

Then click the **OK** button.




6. You should see a blue bar at the top of your screen indicating you are now connected to the **Liberty Cloud** demo server.

Open the **Liberty** program if it does not automatically open.




7. If you are asked for a username and password for liberty, type in **rwd** for the username and password (case sensitive) and then click **OK**

Now you can demo **Liberty software** without having to install anything!.




Microsoft Windows Users – Method 2


1. Click the **Windows start button** and type **remote desktop** and press **Enter** on your keyboard or click the start menu option for **Remote Desktop Connection**.



2. Type **demo.libertydemo.com** in the field labeled **Computer** and click the **Connect** button.




3. If you get a dialog option asking you to verify the connection, checkmark the option for **Don't ask me again for connections to this computer** and then click the **Connect** button.




4. You may see an option to **Use a different account**, click this, if you don't see this option, go ahead and continue typing **demo** for the user name and then **demo** for the password.

Then click the **OK** button.




5. You should see a blue bar at the top of your screen indicating you are now connected to the **Liberty Cloud** demo server. Open the **Liberty** program if it does not automatically open.

Now you can demo **Liberty software** without having to install anything!




Mac Users


1. Open the App Store on your Mac computer.



2. Do a search for **Windows App** and press your **Enter** key.




3. Click the **Get** button and sign in with your **Apple ID** if prompted to download and install the app.




4. The app should give you the option to **Run** it, if you don't see that option, click on the **Windows App** icon at the bottom in the **dock**.



5. Click the next button until the **Welcome to Windows App** closes.



6. Click the **+** dropdown button and select **Add PC**.



7. For **PC name**, type **demo.libertydemo.com**, then for **Friendly name**, type **Liberty Demo** and then click the **Add** button.

8. Double-click the **Liberty Demo** box under **Saved PCs**.



9. For **Username**, type **demo** and for the password, type **demo** (case sensitive), then click the **Continue** button.



10. For this **Verification** dialog box, click the **Continue** button.



11. You should now be signed in to the **Demo Liberty Cloud Server**.
Open the **Liberty** program if it doesn't automatically open.



12. If you are asked for a username and password for **Liberty**, type in **rwd** for the username and password (case sensitive) and then click **OK**

Now you can demo **Liberty Software** without having to install anything!
